A Town of Newbold Town Board Regular Board meeting was held on Thursday, March 25, 2010, in open session, at 6:30 p.m. at the Town of Newbold Town Hall, Highway 47 North, Rhinelander, Wisconsin, 54501, Oneida County, Wisconsin.

Road Report – March 25, 2010

With the unusually warm weather this month we have not had to plow or use any sand. We have about 500 yards of sand left in our stockpile, which is quite a bit more than normal. Unless we get some more winter weather this spring we will be able to cover the pile and use it next winter. It will cost a little more for tarps to cover it, but it should help cut down on how much we need to mix next fall. The broom has been out sweeping for the last two weeks. Most of the southern roads are done and a few northern ones. There is still another couple weeks worth of sweeping to do. The broom has been working very well. We did some patching of potholes last week, trying to get the worst spots done and leaving larger areas for when weight limits are removed.

Weight limits were placed on the roads on March 9. They may be able to be removed in the next couple of weeks but we'll have to see how the weather goes.

The Town's end loader is repaired and ready to be picked up in Green Bay. The dealer ended up putting a new engine in it. The fuel was leaking between a fuel injector sleeve and the block. All the parts and labor are covered by the extended warranty, which expires this July.
