

**MINUTES OF THE TOWN OF NEWBOLD  
TOWN BOARD REGULAR MEETING  
HELD ON THURSDAY SEPTEMBER 24, 2009**

A Town of Newbold Town Board Regular Board meeting was held on Thursday, September 24, 2009, in open session, at 6:30 p.m. at the Town of Newbold Town Hall, Highway 47 North, Rhinelander, Wisconsin, 54501, Oneida County, Wisconsin.

The meeting was called to order by David Kroll, Chairman Newbold Town Board. We purchased 2 cold water rescue suits with the money donated by Wal-Mart and some other fundraiser money.

Road Report – September 24, 2009

In September the road crew has continued with similar work to the last couple of months. We hauled gravel to several roads including – Stone Lake Rd, Northern Gate Dr, Eastern Gate Dr, West Shore Dr, Guthrie Ln, and Shady Ln. We have also done some shoulder work and paving of shoulders in various places. The mower has been out brushing and we have done some hand trimming of trees on a few roads where the trees were right in peoples' yards.

The trucks and equipment have been working well with just a few minor equipment repairs to deal with.

The Velvet Lake Road project has been completed on Velvet Lake Road. The fog seal on Mildred Parkway is also complete.

I am planning on going through some of the roads next Tuesday to review them for road ratings. If any board members would like to go along to inspect roads please let me know.

Highway Landscapers, the company that gave us the price on a guardrail for Bridge Road, came out this week to inspect the site. The curve is sharp enough to require some pre-bent guardrail material to be used. They also recommend using steel posts rather than wood posts because the steel posts can be driven into rock areas more easily. Both of these items increase the price of the guardrail to \$12,500 instead of the \$10,250 previously quoted.
