

Minutes of the Town of Newbold Town Board Finance and Regular Town Board Meeting Held on Thursday, September 8, 2011

The Town of Newbold Town Board met on Thursday, September 8, 2011 at 6:00 p.m. in open session for the Town Board Finance meeting and at 6:30 p.m., in open session for the Town Board Regular Monthly Meeting, at the Town of Newbold Town Hall, Highway 47, North, Rhinelander, Wisconsin, 54501, Oneida County, Wisconsin. The following was discussed:

- Dave Kroll, Chairman called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. The following were in attendance: Dave Kroll, Bob Metropulos, Jim Staskiewicz, Scott Eshelman and Mike Sueflohn, Supervisors; Kim Gauthier, Clerk; Jodie Hess, Treasurer.
- Approval and payment of bills, receipt of financial reports and fund adjustments.
A motion was made by Mr. Staskiewicz and seconded by Mr. Metropulos to approve the bills, as presented. That motion carried on a vote of five ayes and zero nays.
A motion was made by Mr. Metropulos and seconded by Mr. Staskiewicz to approve the finance reports, as presented. That motion carried on a vote of five ayes and zero nays.
- *A motion was made by Mr. Staskiewicz and seconded by Mr. Sueflohn to adjourn the finance meeting at 6:20 p.m. That motion carried on a vote of five ayes and zero nays.*
- 6:30 p.m. The Regular Town Board Meeting was called to order by Mr. Kroll, who also led the audience in the pledge of allegiance. Ms. Gauthier verified that the agenda was properly posted and an affidavit of such posting is on file in the Clerk's office.
- *A motion was made by Mr. Sueflohn and seconded by Mr. Staskiewicz to approve the Town Board Meeting Minutes of August 20, 2011 and August 22, 2011 and August 25, 2011, as presented. That motion carried on a vote of five ayes and zero nays.*
- Rhinelander District Library Representative, Jane Roe was present and noted the library roof repair project has begun. Other activities going on at the library include the start of 2012 budget and the purchase of an e-book system.
- Discussion and possible action on a citizen request for an ordinance banning the carrying of firearms by anyone except law enforcement on all town property except town roads and boat landings. This agenda item was tabled until a later date at which time any board member would like to revisit this agenda item and/or when State laws are more concrete.
- Discussion and action on information received from Oneida County regarding redistricting. This agenda item was tabled until further communication is received from the county.
- Discussion and action on Oneida County Zoning requests, Plan Commission and Citizen Zoning requests, if any. Chairman's Report. Mr. Metropulos noted he had no new information to make comment on.
- County Supervisors Report. Mr. Rudolph was excused. Mr. Metropulos had no new information.
- Town Lakes Committee Report. Mr. Eshelman indicated the Vice Chair, Connie Muckelburg was recently recognized by the UW Extension for her stewardship and leadership.
- Administrative review and action, if necessary, concerning general government, public safety, recycling, sanitation, culture, education, job assignments, project updates, transportation, budget items, fund transfers, and future agenda items.
The Clerk informed the board of the following: The AA group discontinued their on-going rental of the town hall. The Federal mileage reimbursement rate was increased to \$.555 per mile. The town will be switching to a different style of election equipment (touch screen) for handicap voting. This switch is a result of a county wide uniform request and there will be a cost savings.

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- Public Comment and Communication Period per Wisconsin Statutes whereby the Town Board can discuss any matter raised by the public. Chief Waydick indicated the annual fire department picnic was a great success and it is anticipated that financial support was even better than last year. Mr. Waydick also commented on the concealed weapon agenda item.
- Adjournment at 7:06 p.m. *A motion was made by Mr. Metropulos and seconded by Mr. Sueflohn to adjourn. That motion carried on a vote of five ayes and zero nays.*
