FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

As designated by Wisconsin Statute 174-052, all dogs over the age of six months must be licensed. *Licenses cannot be issued without a current veterinarian issued proof of rabies shot certificate.*

If you don't have a copy of the proof of rabies shot certificate, it is your responsibility to request a copy from your veterinarian.

Please be sure to include self-addressed, stamped envelope so tag(s) and license(s) can be mailed to you.

License fees are \$10.00 per dog, unless your dog is *spayed or neutered*, then the fee is \$5.00.

Penalties: a late fee of \$10 shall be assessed for each dog 6 months of age or over if the owner fails to obtain a dog license by **January 31 of the current year.**
