

**OFFICIAL WEED NOTICE
TOWN OF NEWBOLD**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to each and every person who owns, occupies or controls land in the Town of Newbold, County of Oneida, State of Wisconsin, to destroy all noxious weeds, grasses and plants on such property prior to the time in which such plants would mature to the bloom or flower state.

Noxious weeds, grasses and plants shall include but are not limited to the following: Canada Thistle, Leafy Spurge, Creeping Jenny and Field Bind Weed. In addition, all growth of vegetation which becomes a potential hazard to vehicular traffic in vision clearance triangles shall be cut by the owner or occupant of the property.

The above named weeds must be destroyed at such time and in such manner as shall effectively prevent them from bearing seed or spreading to adjoining property as required by Wisconsin Statute 66.0407.
