

Town of Newbold Employment Opportunity

The Town of Newbold in Oneida County, Wisconsin is conducting a survey, developing an inventory, developing a management plan and taking action to address terrestrial invasive species on Town property within the Town. In order to accomplish this, the Town is seeking an Invasive Species Technician, working as a limited term, temporary employee in the Summer of 2018 to conduct various activities, including data collection, mapping, planning, as well as some educational and outreach activities. The position will be supervised by the Town Board's designee. Project is funded by a combination of Town funds, technical assistance from Oneida County departments, the Wisconsin Headwaters Invasive Partnership and funds through the Lumberjack RC&D.

Wage: \$12-14/hour depending on qualifications. This position is not eligible for benefits.

Training and Experience: Knowledge of Wisconsin native and common and invasive plants is essential. An Associates or Bachelor's degree is preferred, though not required. Applicants must be able to communicate effectively, both orally and in writing. Applicants must be proficient with computers and data collection. Applicant needs to have a valid Wisconsin driver's license.
